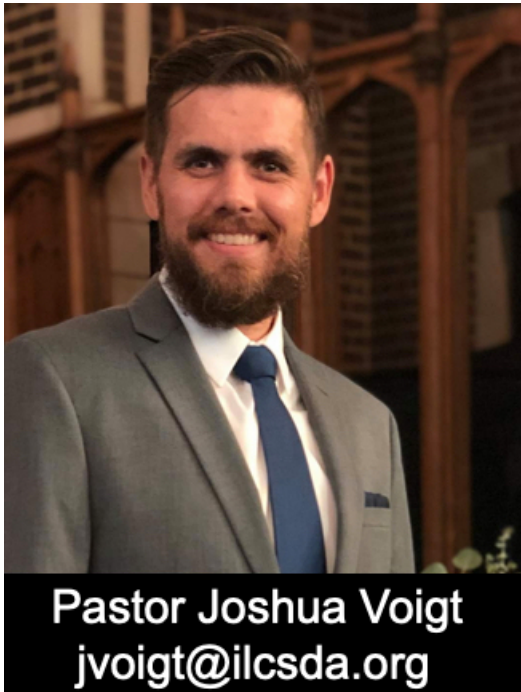


# AN ANTI-CHRIST IN THE PULPIT?
